SYLLABUS of Written Test for Clerk Post

Part I (Clerk Post: 45 Marks)

- A. General Knowledge & Current Affairs:** Questions will be designed to test the candidate's general knowledge of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observation and experience. The test will also include questions relating mainly to the State of West Bengal and other States of India especially pertaining to Sports, History, Literature, Culture and Geography, Economic Scene, Polity etc.
- B. General Intelligence:** The syllabus for General Intelligence would include questions of both verbal and non verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.
- C. General English:** Candidates' understanding of the fundamentals of the English Language such as Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc.
- D. Arithmetic:** Questions of this component will cover number system including questions on simplification, decimals, fractions, LCM, HCF, Average, Ratio and proportion, percentage, profit and loss, discount, simple interest, time and work, time and distance.

Part II (15 Marks)

This part will contain questions related to Ramakrishna Movement & Value-based education.

NOTE

- The questions will be set in both English and Bengali versions.*
- The examination (Part I + Part II) shall be held on a single day for all the eligible candidates and will be of 90 minutes for Clerk post.*
- Both objective (MCQ's) and subjective type of questions will be asked.*
